

5 Areas to Use Symmetrical Balance

Arranging and grouping different elements together using symmetrical balance is a classic way of creating stability and calmness.

WALLS

Arrange art, pictures, or mirrors centered over tables, fireplaces, beds, and sofas.



LIVING ROOM

Center a sofa on a wall or on an area rug. Continue the symmetrical layout by centering the coffee table and artwork, or place matching end tables or chairs on either side of the sofa.



BEDROOM

Center a bed on a wall. Continue the symmetrical layout by centering artwork over the bed, and place matching tables and lamps on either side of the bed.



MANTELS AND SHELVES

Center accessories and other items on a bookshelf, console table, mantel, or coffee table.



SOFAS AND BEDS

Center and space matching pillows evenly on a bed, sofa, or bench.
